



# Education in Emergencies (EiE) Fundamentals

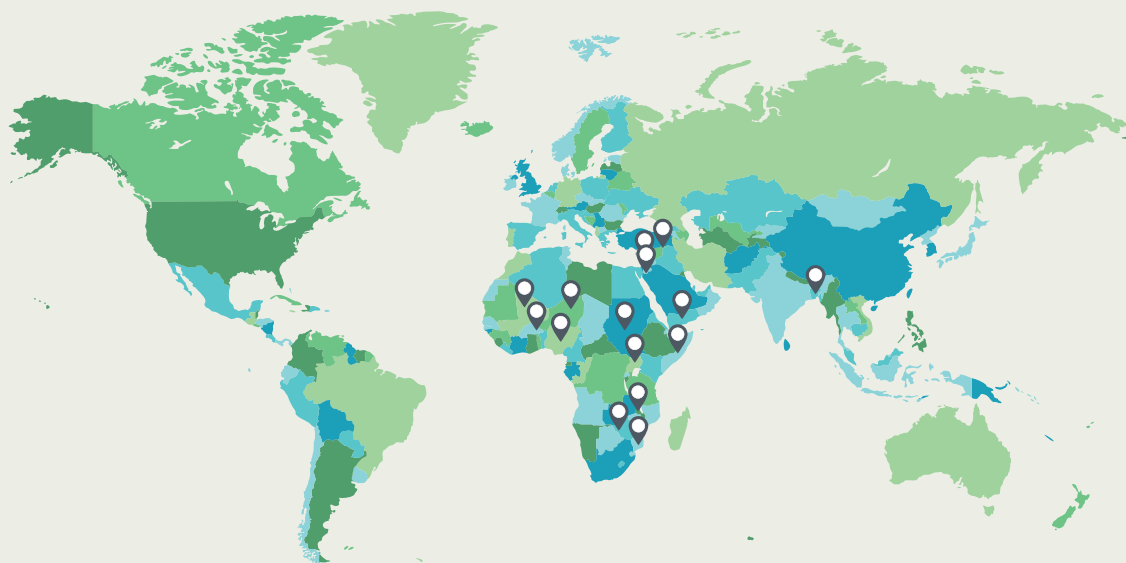
The **Education in Emergencies Fundamentals** course aims to equip country office education and EiE staff with the fundamental competencies to be part of initiating, designing and implementing an EiE response in their context.

The course is sector-facing, typically involving participants from UN agencies, INGOs, national organisations, and governments. The course is part of our Education in Emergencies (EiE) Professional Development Programme (PDP), delivered by our regional teams to target countries or responses on demand, typically in collaboration with the country/response Education Cluster or Working Group.

The course is delivered to **cohorts of up to 30 learners**, as an intensive week-long in-person training or as a less intensive remotely facilitated training over a period of 2-3 months, depending on the needs of the context.

The course involves some pre-work (through EiE Online or document pre-reads) and typically involves **35-50 hours of learning**. The course is increasingly supported and delivered by graduates from the EiE Advanced/CAS course as part of the programmes pay-it-forward clause and sustainability model.

EiE Fundamentals has so far reached **over 540 learners** in Nigeria, Lebanon, Syria, Zimbabwe, India, Malawi, Mozambique, Sudan, Somalia, Burkina Faso, Mali, Niger, South Sudan, Jordan and Yemen.
